*A - Monthly Calling Plan Charge

• Charge applicable to any monthly calling plan such as unlimited long distance calling on your wireline bill or unlimited minutes on your wireless bill.

*B - Telecommunications Sales Tax, Sales Tax, and Sales Tax-Video

These taxes are imposed by state, local, and municipal governments on goods and services.

*C - FUSF (VoIP) Federal Universal Service Charges

 The Universal Service Fund (USF) provides support to promote access to telecommunications services at reasonable rates for those living in rural and high-cost areas, income-eligible consumers, rural health care facilities, and schools and libraries.

*D - E911 (VoIP) Includes Both of the Following:

- 911 Charge imposed by local governments to help pay for emergency services such as fire and rescue.
- **Telecommunications Relay Service** Charge to help pay for the relay center that transmits and translates calls for people with hearing or speech disabilities.

*E - FCC Regulatory Fee (VoIP)

• Telephone and Video/Cable fee required by service providers in support of the regulatory work of the Federal Communications commission (FCC).

Other Use Related Charges

- **Directory Assistance** Any charges for placing 411 or (area code) 555-1212 directory assistance calls.
- Operator Assisted Calls Charges for any calls connected by an operator. Rates for these
 calls generally are higher than rates for unassisted calls.
- Local Number Portability (LNP) Telephone number portability allows residential and business
 customers to retain, at the same location, their existing local telephone numbers when switching
 from one telephone service provider to another. These fees are not taxes.
- **Federal Excise Tax** This three percent tax is now applied only to local service billed separately from long distance service.
